HOW TO SILVER-LEAF GLASS

Donna's secret for giving glass that gorgeous aged look is applying layers of delicate silver leaf, which she gets from L. Cornelissen & Son. She sometimes enhances the effect by putting pieces of lace or pictures behind the silver, too.

- 1 Dilute a little gelatin in warm water. Rub onto clean glass with cotton wool.

- 2 Lay a sheet of silver leaf transfer onto the damp glass and peel back the transfer paper, leaving the silver behind. Repeat, butting the squares up to one another.
- 3 Allow to dry for several hours, then gently burnish the silver with a soft cloth to flatten any wrinkles and create the mirroring on the other side of the glass.
